History

The Lucerne Christkindlimarkt was held in the RailCity Lucerne for the first time in 2003. Following the success of the Zurich Christkindlimarkt, which was introduced in 1994, organisational committee (OK) Christkindlimarkt launched a second market in Lucerne's main railway station. This year's market will be the seventh Lucerne Christkindlimarkt. Around 50 festively-decorated market stalls will bring a Christmassy feel to the station.
